



Project title: The Nature of Neck Pain in Migraine

What is the relationship between migraine and the neck?

Study Purpose

Many people with migraine also have neck pain, but it is not known how migraine is related to neck pain. By understanding migraine and neck pain, UQ Researchers hope to eventually help management of migraine.

Volunteer Criteria:

Age range: 18 to 65 years

We are seeking volunteers for the following groups

- 1. Suffer migraine headache and have neck pain with headaches**
- 2. Suffer migraine, but have no neck pain**
3. Suffer neck pain but do not suffer from headache
4. Have no headaches and no neck pain

Location: Brisbane

Requirements of study:

Online questionnaires and a **single** session of clinical tests on movements, joints and muscles of the neck and balance system at the University of Queensland St Lucia. The session will take approximately 2 hours.

Parking permit at the University of Queensland St Lucia will be provided for the day of testing.
