

# Are you an adult migraine sufferer?

Participants are requested for a study examining migraines in Australians.

School of Biomedical Sciences.

## Focus of Study

I am a student from Charles Sturt University's School of Biomedical Science and undertaking research into the experiences of adult migraine sufferers in Australia as part of my Masters degree. The number, frequency, severity and other characteristics of migraine sufferers' experience is of interest to try to understand any trends in migraine in an Australian population.

## Who can participate?

Anyone aged 18 and older, who does not have a history of stroke, epilepsy, hypertension (high blood pressure) or other diagnosed headache conditions (as these may alter the results).

## What is involved?

After responding to this advertisement, you will be provided a Participant Information Statement which will outline the study in detail. Should you be interested, you will be invited to a short telephone conversation (5-10 minutes) to ask questions about your migraine characteristics, and to arrange for project materials to be posted to you. Following this, completion of two headache diaries (June/July 2020 – 30 September 2020, and from 1 October 2020 to 30 January 2021). This will involve filling in a short form each time you have a migraine during this time. The form will ask you to answer four simple questions about the characteristics of your migraine experience (date, time of onset, duration, severity, and other symptoms).

## Duration

7 months (intermittent participation)

## Other information:

All necessary information and materials will be provided to you and the research team with be available to you throughout the study should you need any assistance. Participation is entirely voluntary, and participants will not be paid for their time but withdrawal is possible at any stage until February 2021 should involvement become cumbersome.
